

**EUDY SIMELANE'S PARTIALLY CLOTHED body was found dumped in a creek outside Johannesburg in 2008. She had been gang-raped, beaten, and stabbed 25 times, from her face to the soles of her feet. She was a former midfielder for South Africa's national women's football team, and a lesbian.**

South Africa was the first country in the world to grant equal rights to LGBT people, but homophobic attacks like "corrective rape" are increasing and discrimination prevents out athletes from playing in the national football league. In 2004, a group of lesbians formed the Chosen FEW. Ten years later, it remains the only openly queer football team in the country, with no dedicated training field. "We don't have a place to play," says striker and occasional goalkeeper Bathandwa Mosho. "Why not? Because people are homophobic; they don't want lesbians to play."

"In football, 'gay' is still a swear word," retired German midfielder Thomas Hitzlsperger told magazine *Die Zeit* when he came out in January 2014. No active Premier League footballer has ever come out, and although Italian national team manager Cesare Prandelli invited his gay footballers to do so in April 2012, all seem to have declined. For international players, leaving the closet could mean leaving the pitch; queer foreigners risk deportation from Russia, FIFA's chosen host for the 2018 World Cup, and Qatar, 2022 host, reportedly plans to start screening visitors for homosexuality as they arrive.

LE CORPS À MOITIÉ NU d'Eudy Simelane fut retrouvé près de Johannesburg en 2008. Violée collectivement, battue et poignardée 25 fois, du visage à la plante des pieds, Eudy était ex-milieu de terrain de l'équipe nationale féminine de football d'Afrique du Sud, et lesbienne.

L'Afrique du Sud fut le premier pays à accorder la parité aux LGTB, mais les attaques homophobes comme les « viols correctifs » augmentent et la discrimination empêche les athlètes de jouer dans la ligue nationale de football. En 2004, un groupe de lesbiennes forma les Chosen FEW. Dix ans plus tard, cette équipe de foot demeure la seule ouvertement gay du pays, sans terrain à elle pour s'entraîner. « Nous n'avons pas d'endroit où jouer », dit Bathandwa Mosho, attaquante et parfois gardienne. « Pourquoi ? Parce que les gens sont homophobes ; ils ne veulent pas que les lesbiennes jouent. »

« Dans le football, 'gay' est encore un gros mot », a déclaré le milieu de terrain allemand retraité Thomas Hitzlsperger au quotidien *Die Zeit* à l'occasion de son coming out en janvier 2014. Aucun footballeur de la Premier League en activité n'a jamais fait de coming out, et bien qu'en 2012 l'entraîneur de l'équipe nationale italienne Cesare Prandelli avait invité ses joueurs gais à le faire, tout est retombé dans l'oubli. Pour les joueurs internationaux, sortir de l'ombre pourrait signifier sortir du terrain ; en Russie, pays qui accueillera la Coupe du Monde 2018, les étrangers gais risquent l'expulsion, et le Qatar, pays hôte en 2022, aurait le projet d'enquêter sur l'homosexualité des visiteurs dès leur arrivée.
